

Survey of NM Evaluation Lab @ UNM Fellows from 2015-2016

The Survey of Fellows contained items that asked Fellows to identify their abilities on a variety of evaluation competencies prior to and then after being part of the NM Evaluation Lab @ UNM. The first chart shows the average for each item before the Evaluation Lab and then the average amount of change in perceived ability. The 6-point scale the students used to respond was:

- 0 = I don't know what that is
- 1 = Do not feel comfortable doing
- 2 = Can do with a lot of guidance
- 3 = Can do with light supervision
- 4 = Can do on my own
- 5 = Can teach someone else to do it

The survey also included items asking Fellows about the helpfulness of individual components of the Lab. The second chart shows the average response for each item. The 3-point scale students used to respond was:

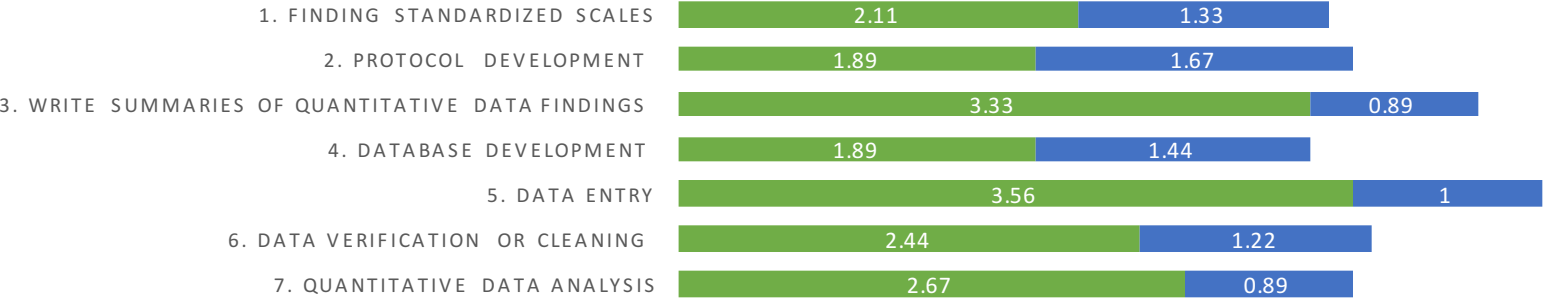
- 1 = Less helpful
- 2 = Helpful
- 3 = Very Helpful

The survey was completed by 9 of the 10 Fellows in the 2015-2016 cohort.



Perception of competencies **before** NM Evaluation Lab and subsequent **growth**

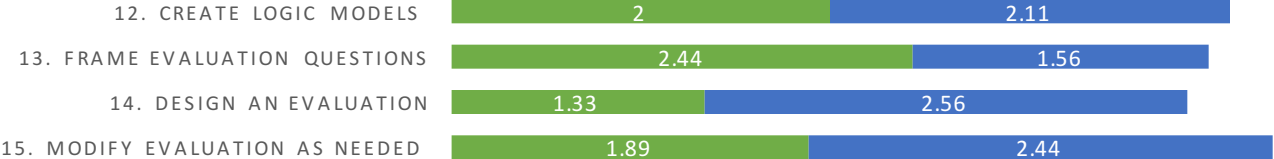

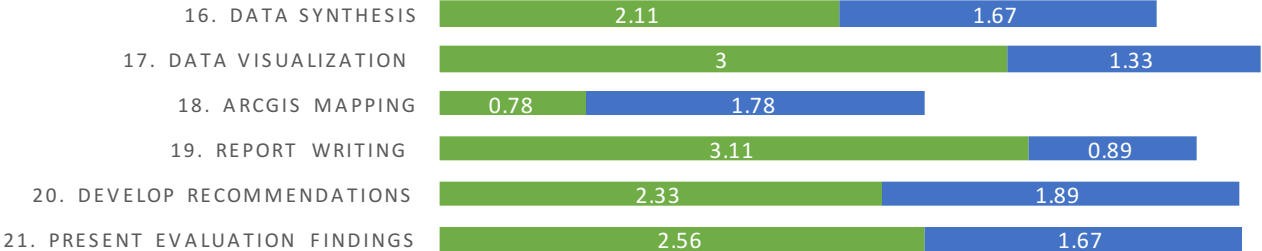

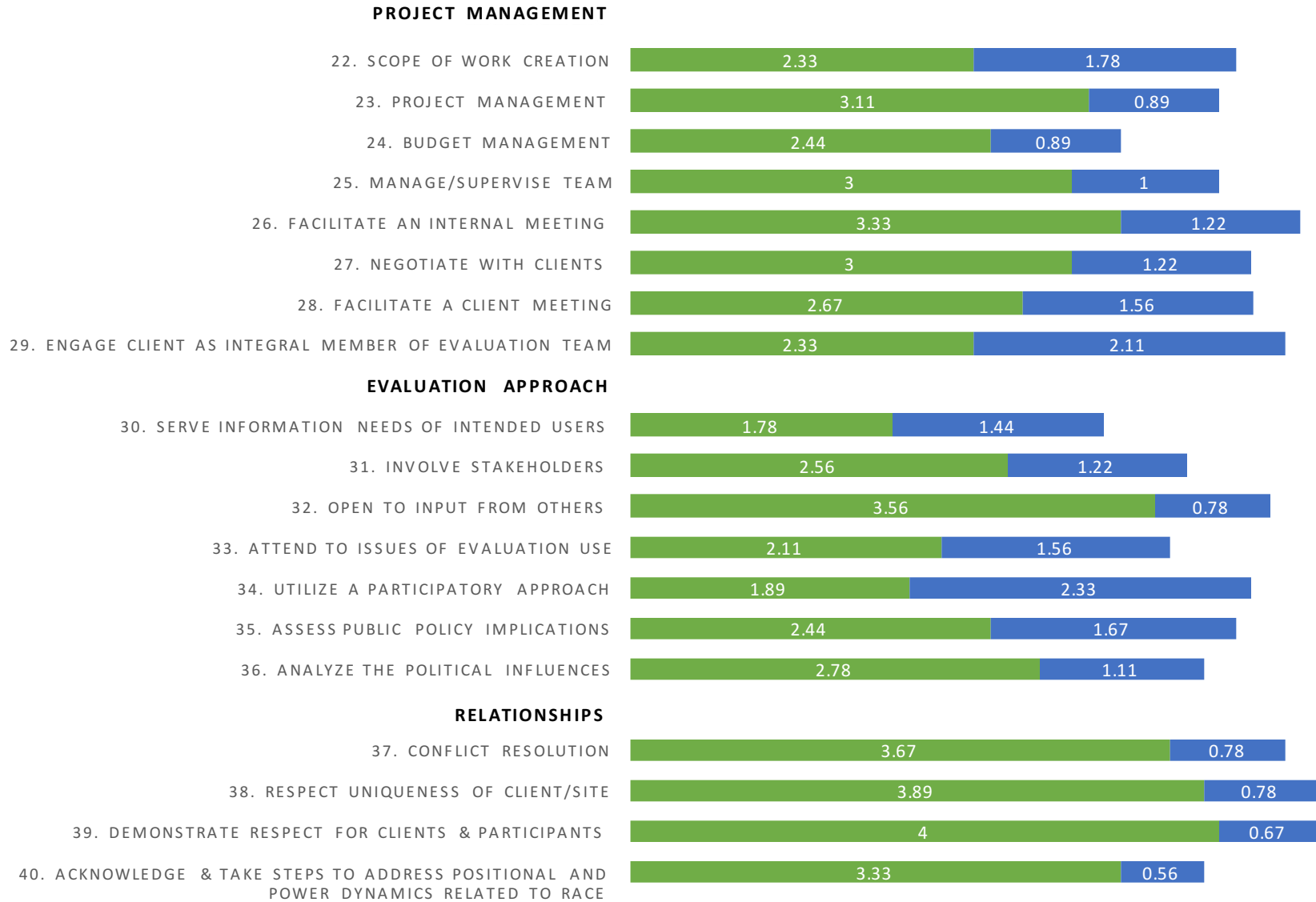

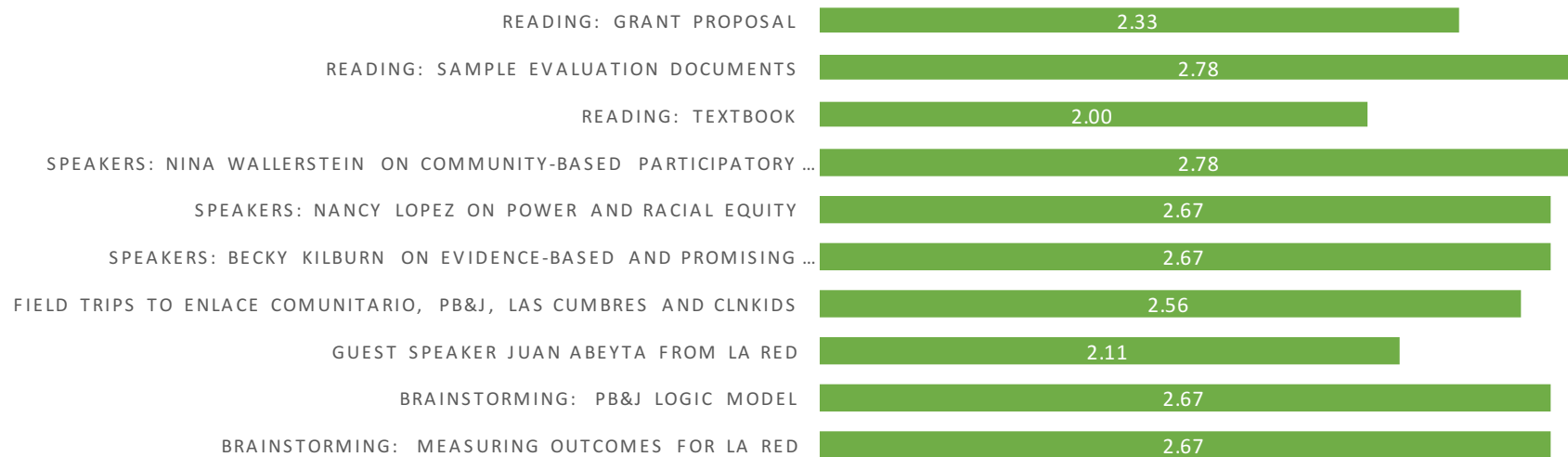


Perception of competencies **before** NM Evaluation Lab and subsequent **growth**

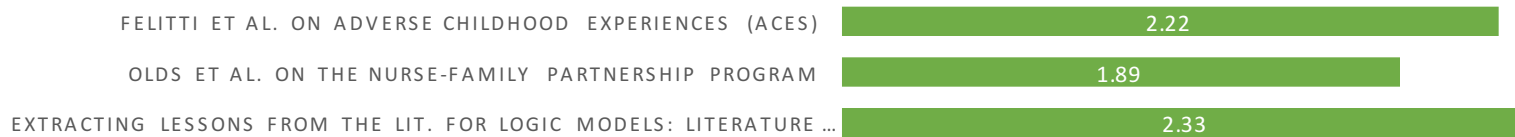

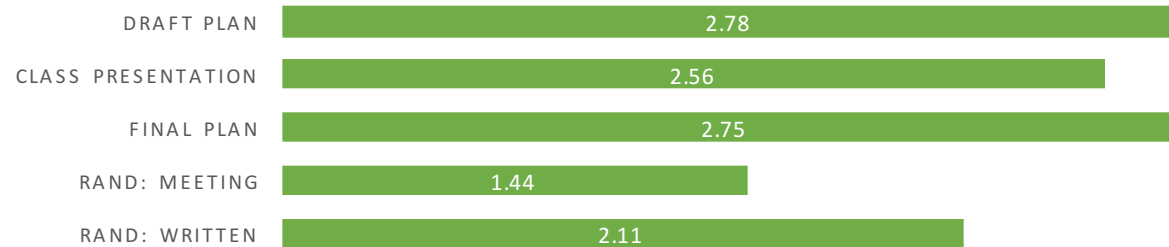

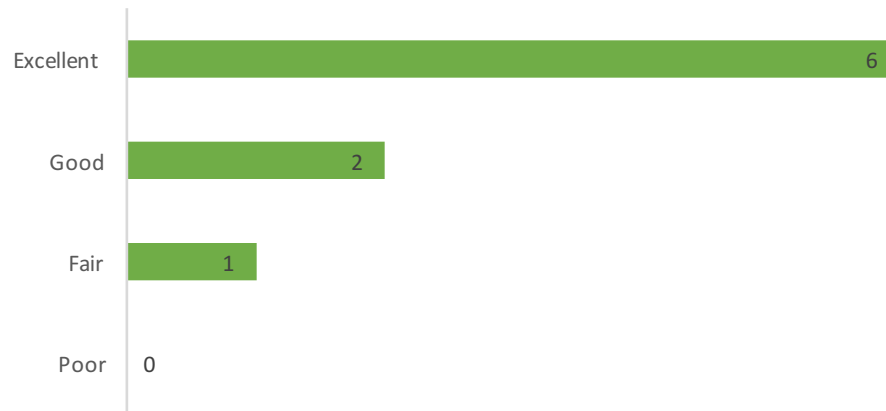
