# TIPS FOR MANAGEABLE DATA COLLECTION

- Keep it simple: dial down to what you need to know
- Be clear in the instructions
- Transcribe data into Excel, Word, or a coding program
  - **Line by line**
  - **Paragraph style**

# PROS AND CONS OF CODING TOGETHER VS ALONE

## Individual Coding

### Pros

- Faster!
- Flexible timeframe
- Possibly less aggravating
- Greater continuity of codes

### Cons

- Limited buy-in
- No discussion
- Greater opportunity for bias
- Less accountability

## Group Coding

### Pros

- Thorough
- Buy-in
- Rich discussion
- Reduction of bias (perhaps)

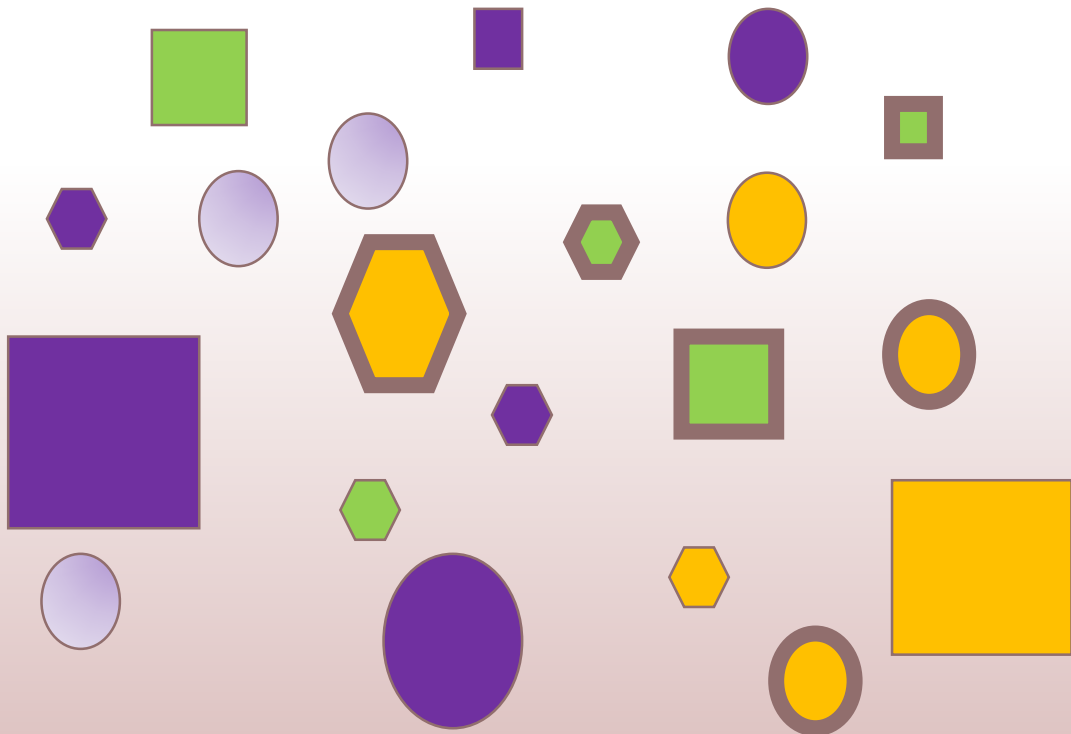
### Cons

- Slower!
- Can produce conflict
- Less flexible timeframe
